**Siemens Energy wins 'Best Health, Safety, Environment/Sustainable Development Offshore Award' at 2021 World Oil Awards**

**October 15, 2021, HOUSTON** — The 2021 World Oil Awards recognized the upstream oil and gas industry's leading innovations and thought leaders, in a first-of-its-kind hybrid event.

This year, 295 nominations were submitted from companies in more than a dozen countries around the world. One hundred and two finalists were selected, and the award winners were hand-picked by the *World Oil Awards* advisory board as this year's most groundbreaking industry developments.

Honorees received awards in 18 categories, encompassing the full breadth of the upstream industry. Today's innovations, many of which would have seemed far-fetched a generation ago, are enabling operators to find and produce hydrocarbons more safely, economically and efficiently.

In this year's 'Best Health, Safety, Environment/Sustainable Development Offshore Award' category, Siemens Energy won for Spontaneous Leak Detection, powered by ProFlex Technologies. Siemens Energy's expertise in cloud computing, IoT, and data analytics detects the presence of a leak within a pipeline in a matter of seconds, and with accuracy in the range of 20 and 50 feet. Their Spontaneous Leak Detection System represents a highly effective, economical, and scalable solution for detecting the presence and location of small spontaneous leaks in real time. It is likely that it, along with fiberoptic sensing and other IoT-based techniques, will eventually become the standard, as the industry drives toward a more environmentally conscious future.
